

Participants throw an object and recite the alphabet as they make successful catches.



- Split participants into pairs. If you have an odd number, create a mix of groups of two and three.
- Give each pair an object to pass back and forth such a beanbag, paper ball, foam ball, etc.
- Participants begin throwing the object back and forth. For each successful catch the pair recite the next letter of the alphabet.
- If a catch is missed, restart at A.
- The goal is to complete the alphabet.
- This game can be varied to recite the alphabet in different orders, or spell words.
